

Places of Interest

The Mall

The Mall is a 1.5 km promenade that connects the Library Bazar and is the most popular part of the town.

The Camel's Back Road

This is 3 km loop that connects the Library Bazar to the Picture Palace. It is quiet and ideal for refreshing walk with mountain views. A natural rock formation in the shape of a camel's hump gives the road its name.

Lake

6 km away on the Mussoorie-Dehradun road is this manmade lake which is another tourist attraction that offers boating along with scenic views of the Doon Valley.

Gun Hill

It is a very popular destination for tourists affording sight of all the landmarks of the town and also of the snow peak such as Badarpoonch (20713 Ft), Kedarnath (22304 Ft), Badrinath (22478 Ft) and even Nandadevi (25640 Ft). The energetic, may trek up the 2 KM winding path to Gun Hill, or take the ever popular cable car called the Ropeway.

Bhatta Falls

Series of well-maintained ponds that have facilities for bathing and other activities. It's an ideal location for a relaxed picnic.

Company Garden

Also known as Botanical Gardens of Mussoorie. It is easily accessible by road from Library Bazar. The gardens are well laid out and offer paddle boating in a small man made lake as well as other amusements.

Kempty Falls

Kempty Falls are at a distance of 15 kms from Mussoorie. Discovered and developed by John Mekinan and favored for the evening parties or 'camp tea' in those days. The spectacular cascade is a group of 5 falls, the highest being over 40 meters with the water collecting in a pool at the bottom.

Char Dukan

This cluster of four tea stalls next to the St. Paul's church offers some of the best paranthas, sandwiches, pancakes with maple syrup and the ever popular Maggi. An early morning visit with an empty stomach can be a most rewarding experience.

Lal Tibba

This is the highest point in Mussoorie that now has an army establishment. A viewing tower by the Cliffside with the telescope now goes by the name of Lal Tibba & offers magnificent view of the snow clad peaks.

Sister's Bazar

The towering Oaks, Pines & Deodars host a perfect summer getaway. Taking a walk or a trail in this area is an absolute delight. The Prakash Brother's store at Sister's Bazar is a great attraction for its scrumptious confectionaries, preserves and cheese that loyal customers swear by.

Dhanaulti

Known as its scenic location amidst Oak, Deodar and Rhododendron forest, Dhanaulti, 35 km from Mussoorie, has peace and tranquility as well as a 180 degree panormic view of snow-capped peaks. It is a perfect getaway for those seeking to escape the hustle bustle of everyday life and want to commune with nature.
